**DID YOU KNOW?** ANSI and OSHA have strict guidelines on 10 First Aid Kit components?

## ANSI Z308.1-2009 Required Contents

In order to be ANSI compliant, First Aid Kits must contain the following components:

- | Qty.  | Item and Minimum Size or Volume                        |

| 16    | Adhesive Bandages, 1" x 3"                             |

| 10    | Antiseptic, 0.14 fl. oz. (0.5g) applications           |
| 6     | Burn Treatment, 1/32 oz. (0.9g) applications           |
| 1     | First Aid Guide  |
| 2 pr. | Medical Exam Gloves                                    |
| 4     | Sterile Pads, 3" x 3"                                  |
| 1     | Triangular Bandage, 40" x 40" x 56"                    |

# Understanding OSHA

## A guide to OSHA Regulations for First Aid Kits

### U.S Department of Labor Occupational Safety & Health Administration

**OSHA** is the main federal agency charged with the enforcement of safety and health legislation.

**OSHA** regulations are contained in 29 CFR 1910.151 and Appendix A.

**OSHA** does not provide specifications for first aid kit contents per se but requires that they be available and through Appendix A defers to **ANSI** for kit specifications and minimum contents. See ANSI requirements below.

Appendix A adds recommendations in addition to ANSI standards for larger, unique or changing workplace environments and anticipates exposure to blood born pathogens with requirements for personal protective equipment.

**OSHA** regulations pertaining to First Aid Kits are published in the Code of Federal Regulations as: 29 CFR 1910-151, Appendix A, a non-mandatory guideline and 1910.1030 (d)(3) Personal Protective Equipment.
